**LISLE TOWNSHIP BUDGET HEARING**

**MINUTES OF THE 2019 BUDGET, TOWN AND G.A. NOVEMBER 14, 2018**

CALL TO ORDER: The Regular Meeting of the Board of Township Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Mullen at 7:10 p.m. at the Lisle Township office, 4711 Indiana Avenue, Lisle, IL.

**Public Comments:**

Rick Tarulis addressed the board expressing his disagreement with the township returning to a fiscal year instead of running concurrently with the calendar year. Mr. Tarulis asserted that it confuses the public when a governmental unit's year does not align with the calendar year. He maintained that it would affect the audit process for the year 2019, one for the first three months and a second for the trailing 12 months. Among his other concerns were that it could complicate reporting of IMRF funding levels and IRS reports since both were based on a calendar year.

Mr. Tarulis next asserted that many government units have switched to a calendar fiscal year, but none that had switched from a calendar year to an odd fiscal year. He also expressed his belief that since the taxation was based on the calendar year that the budget should be. In conclusion Mr. Tarulis requested that his concerns be entered in the minutes.

He next commented that he felt there may be a typo in the resolution that the board passed in September regarding dates and said that the board should double check them to make sure they are correct.

There being no further public comment, the supervisor asked for a motion to adjourn the budget hearing for the Town and General Assistance Funds.

**Adjournment:**

Motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Tams; it was seconded by Trustee Riedy. Voice vote, all present in favor, motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:14 p.m.
