2. Public Comments: None.

3. Approval of Minutes: Motion by Trustee Smith to approve the minutes of the December 10, 2003 regular Town Board meeting. Second by Trustee Potterton. Voice vote, all in favor, motion passed.

4. Presentation of Tentative Budgets for 2004-2005: Tentative budgets for the Township and Road District were presented to Trustees. The Assessor's budget is not updated in this draft, but will increase only slightly. Supervisor Clarke highlighted certain expenses in the budget and explained differences from last year's budget. Supervisor Clarke and Trustees agreed to hold a special meeting for a budget workshop on Tuesday, January 27, at 6:30 p.m. to review the budgets.

5. Report of Township Supervisor: Supervisor Clarke reported that the gas lines under the new building site were relocated today, so excavation can proceed. Mr. Clarke advised that the Lisle Chamber of Commerce will be on the agenda for the February meeting to discuss the proposed downtown Lisle TIF District.

6. Reports of Township Officers: Trustee Potterton reported that he had quadruple bypass surgery four weeks ago, and has had such an excellent recovery that he didn't have to miss a Township meeting. Assessor Trowbridge reported that Barb Kubes from his office passed away from cancer. Ms. Kubes will be missed. Her position has been filled already. Trustee Potterton discussed the next newsletter which will be prepared soon.

7. Audit of Expenditures:

Motion by Trustee Smith to audit expenditures. Second by Trustee Potterton. Voice vote, all in favor, motion passed.



MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF JANUARY 27, 2004

CALL TO ORDER: The Special Meeting of the Board of Town Trustees was called to order at 6:30 p.m. at the Lisle Township office, 4721 Indiana Avenue, Lisle, IL, by Supervisor Clarke.

2. Public Comments: None.

3. Budget Workshop: The tentative Budgets for the Township and Road District were presented and discussed.

Supervisor Clarke advised that the new building liability insurance has been included in the budget, as well as utilities and telephone expenses. A new part time receptionist will be hired for the new building. A new computer program is needed. Legal expenses are primarily for tax objection cases. Group insurance rates have increased only slightly. The 1994 van has had high repair bills lately, and a new van is included in the budget.

Supervisor Clarke has budgeted for an increase in the cash allowance for general assistance. The amount will increase to \$250 from \$200. Lisle Township is currently providing the lowest cash assistance to GA recipients in the County, and the amount has not been increased for approximately 15 years. The budget also includes the premium for catastrophic insurance for general assistance, and the cost of one deductible (\$20,000).

Assessor Trowbridge reviewed his office's budget proposal. The total budget is 2.4% higher than last year. The only lines in the budget that are increasing are salaries and computers.

Motion by Trustee Potterton to approve and post the tentative budget for the Township.
Second by Trustee Smith.

Highway Commissioner Dow reviewed the Road District budget. He noted increases in salaries, insurances and IMRF retirement contributions. The Workman's Compensation Fund is in a deficit at the present time, and this budget will place the fund back into surplus.

Motion by Trustee Potterton to approve and post the tentative budget for the Road District. Second by Trustee Smith.


