RESOLUTION 2020 - 01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE LISLE TOWNSHIP BOARD
PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION TO THE
VOTERS OF THE TOWNSHIP A PROPOSITION TO AUTHORIZE
AN ANNUAL TAX AT A RATE NOT TO EXCEED 0.15% FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PROVIDING COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH
FACILITIES AND SERVICES AT THE GENERAL ELECTION
TO BE HELD ON THE 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER 2020**

WHEREAS, Lisle Township (the “*Township*”) is an Illinois local government created and existing under the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Community Mental Health Act (the “*Act*”), 405 ILCS 20/2, grants the Township the power to construct, repair, operate, maintain and regulate community mental health facilities to provide mental health services, and to create a local community mental health board in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act authorize a township to present to its voters the question of whether the township should levy a property tax to for the purpose of providing community mental health facilities and services including facilities and services for the person with a developmental disability or a substance use disorder; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board does hereby find and determine that it is in the best interest of the Township to place a question on the ballot asking the voters of Lisle Township whether such a tax should be authorized; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Election Code, before such proposition may be submitted to the electors of the Township, the Township must adopt an Resolution not later than 79 days prior to the date of the election at which the question shall appear on the ballot and submit the Resolution to the County Clerk not later than 68 days prior to that election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of Lisle Township, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. *Incorporation of Recitals.* The above recitals are incorporated into this Resolution by reference.

SECTION 2. *Submission to County Clerk.* Upon adoption, this Resolution shall be certified and submitted to the Clerk of DuPage County, Illinois.

SECTION 3. *Submission to the Voters.* The Proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the Township in accordance with the general election law at the general election to be held on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November 2020 (the “*Election*”).

SECTION 4. *Voting Precincts and Polling Places.* The Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the County Board of The County of DuPage, Illinois (“*DuPage County Board*”), for voters of the Township.

SECTION 5. *Election Notice.* The County Clerk of DuPage County (the “*County Clerk*”) shall give notice of the Election, including the Spanish translation thereof if required by law, (the “*Notice*”), in accordance with the general election law by:

- (i) publishing the Notice once not more than 60 nor less than 10 days prior to the date of the Election in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the Township, and
- (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at the Clerk’s principal office.

SECTION 6. *Local Notice.* The Clerk of the Township shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the Township.

SECTION 7. *Form of Notice.* The Notice shall appear over the name or title of the County Clerk and shall be substantially in the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the general election to be held on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November 2020, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of the Lisle Township, DuPage County, Illinois:

Shall Lisle Township levy an annual tax of not to exceed .15% for the purpose of providing community mental health facilities and services including facilities and services for the person with a developmental disability or a substance use disorder?

The polls at said election will be open at 6:00 o'clock A.M. and continue to be open until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of that day.

SECTION 8. *Form of Ballot.* The ballot to be used at the Election, including the Spanish translation thereof if deemed by the County Clerk to be required by law, shall be in substantially the following form, with such necessary alterations, changes, deletions and insertions as may be required by Articles 24A, 24B or 24C of the Election Code if an electronic, mechanical or electric voting system is used at the Election:

SECTION 9. *Election Judges.* The Election shall be conducted by the election judges appointed by the County Board to act in the precincts at which the Proposition will be submitted to the voters of the Township.

SECTION 10. *Filing of Resolution.* After the adoption hereof, the Clerk of the Township shall timely certify a copy hereof to the Clerk of DuPage County in order that the Proposition may be presented to the voters of the Township at the Election.

SECTION 11. *Canvass of Election.* The Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and time as provided by the general election law.

SECTION 12. *Severability.* If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 13. *Effective Date.* This Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval as required by law.
