Assessor Trowbridge: Noting that the annual town meeting had just concluded, Assessor Trowbridge said he had no report.

Highway Commissioner Young: Noting the same reason, Commissioner Young had no report.

Supervisor Mullen:

The supervisor began her report by informing the board that that she had made changes to the emergency assistance and general assistance as Laura Pantaleo had alluded to at the annual town meeting. She noted that she was handing out the changes to be entered into the record; the changes took effect April 1, 2019. The general assistance increased from \$400.00 to \$425.00 for individuals. There are also two things which are changing for emergency assistance; the first is that the level for eligibility is going from 150% of poverty level to 175% of poverty level. The other change being made is in the amount available; the amount for an individual is going from \$400.00 to \$700.00 and the amount for a family is going to \$1,000.00, this increase is to be focused on rental assistance. She noted that these changes were to get Lisle Township's neediest families closer to half way to having their needs meant.

Other Business:

It was noted by Bill Green that Lisle Township's Shred Day in conjunction DuPage County would be held Saturday, April 27.
